President's Message

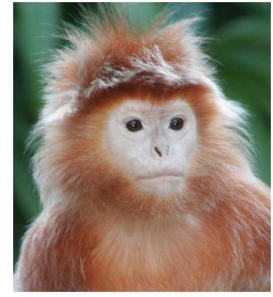
