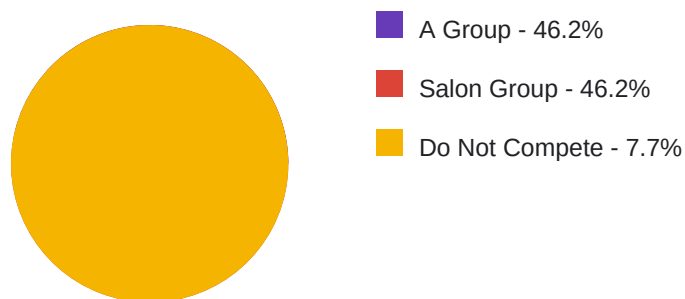
How long have you been a member of SEQCC?

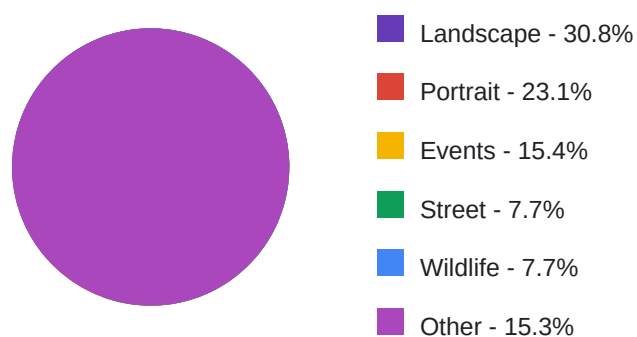
What is your current competition level?

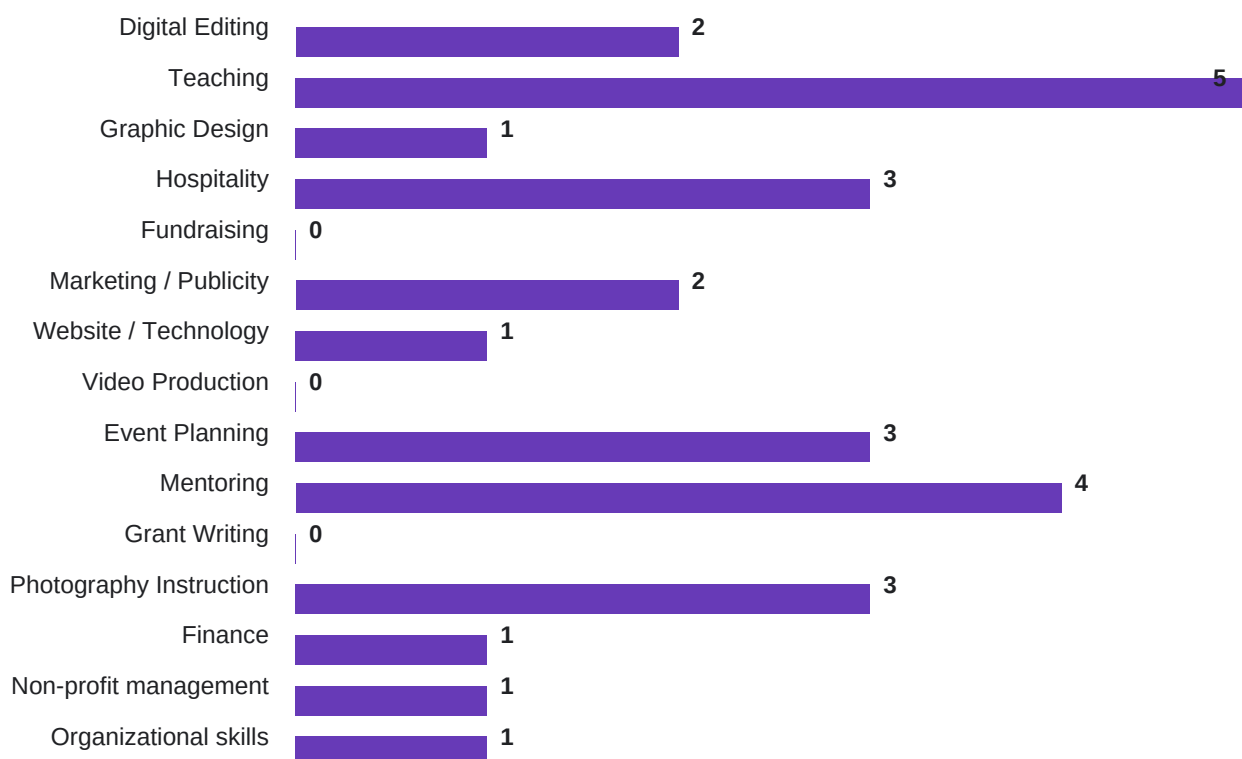


What type of photography interests you most?

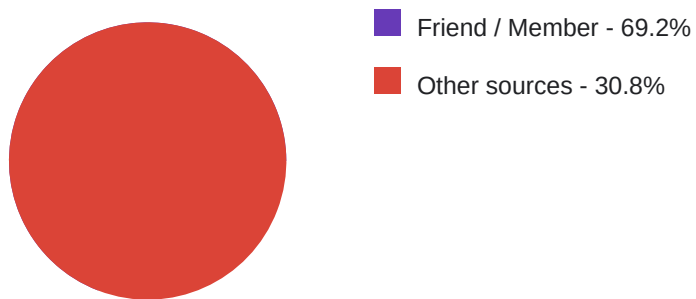
**What skills do you bring to the club? (Select up to 3)**

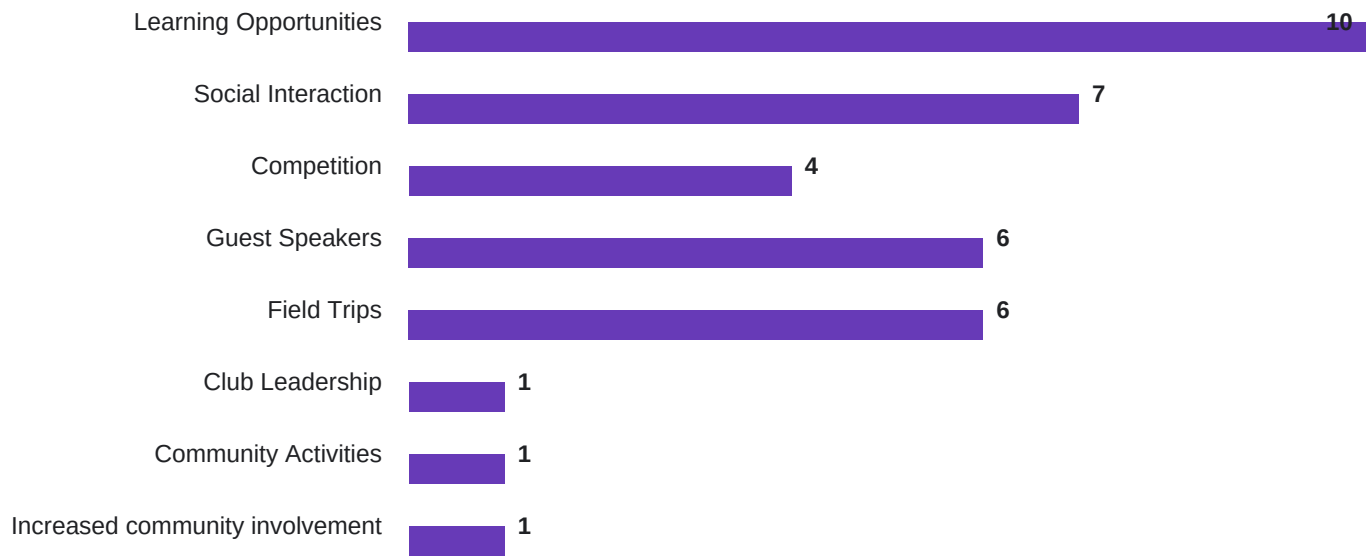
**To what extent do you feel connected, encouraged and valued as a member of SEQCC?**

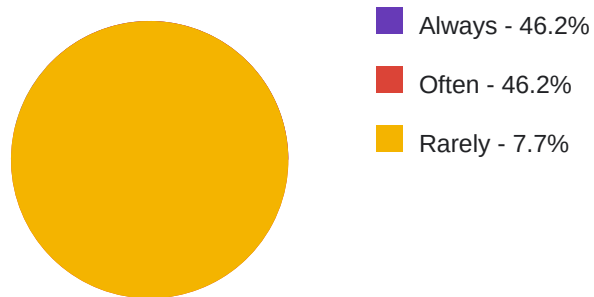

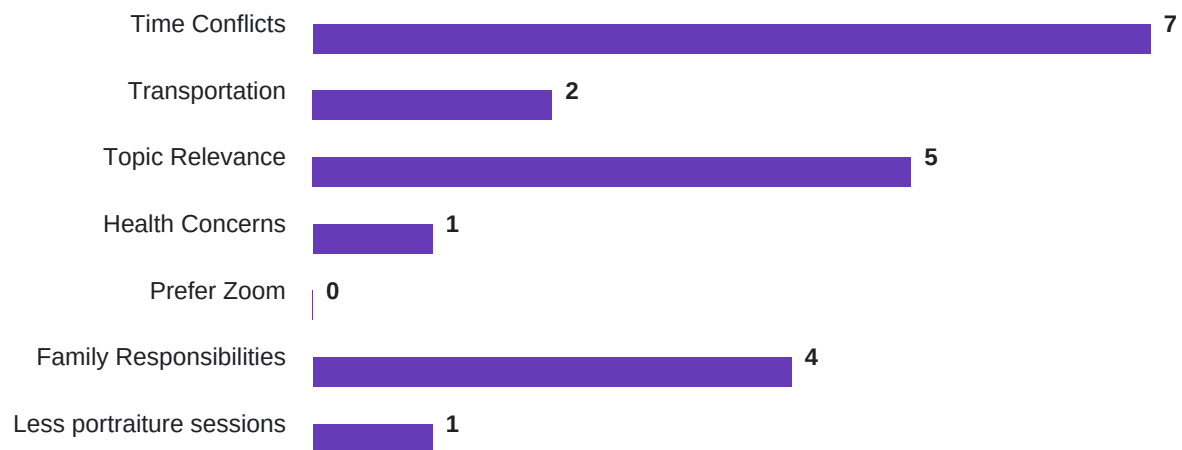
How often do you attend meetings?

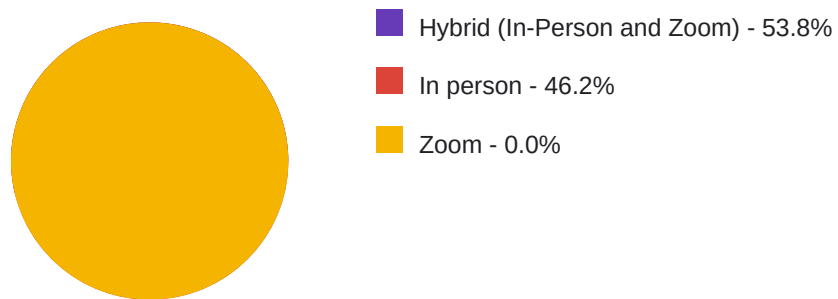
What factors limit your ability or interest in attending meetings?

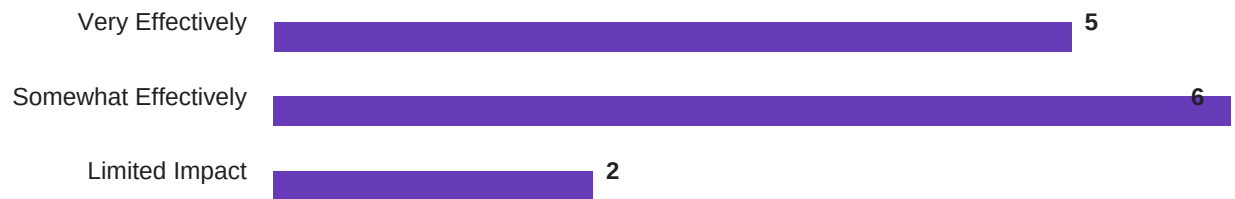
Which meeting format would make you most likely to attend regularly?

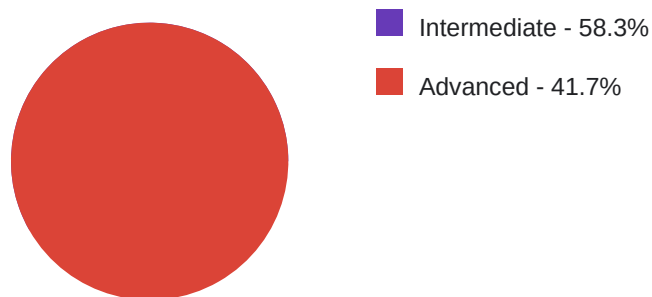

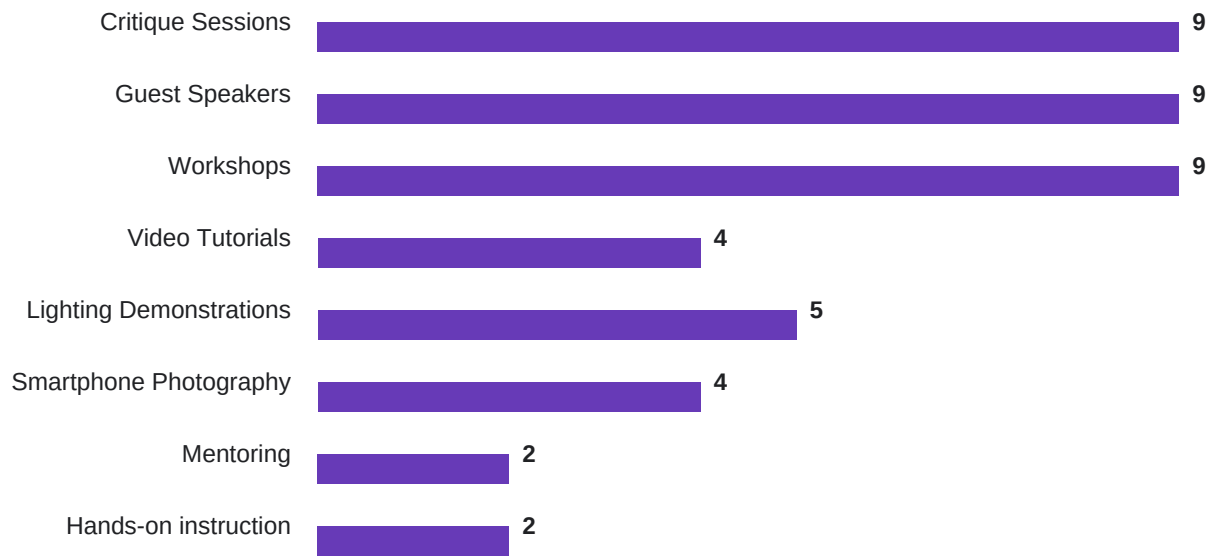
**What level best describes your photography skills?**

What types of programs would increase your participation?

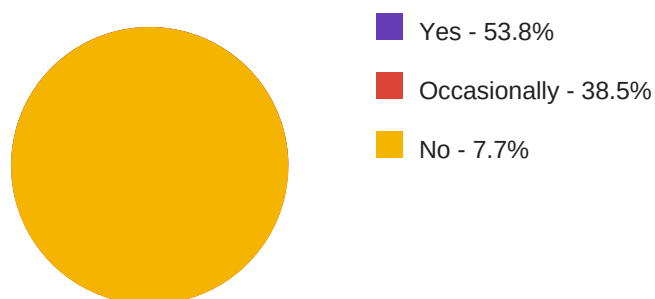

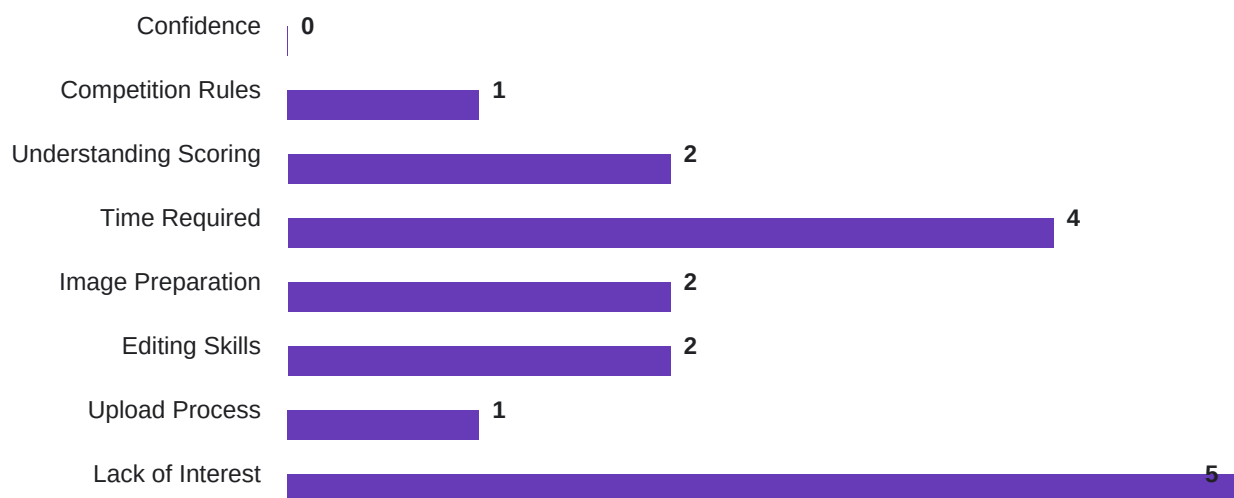
Do you actively participate in competition?

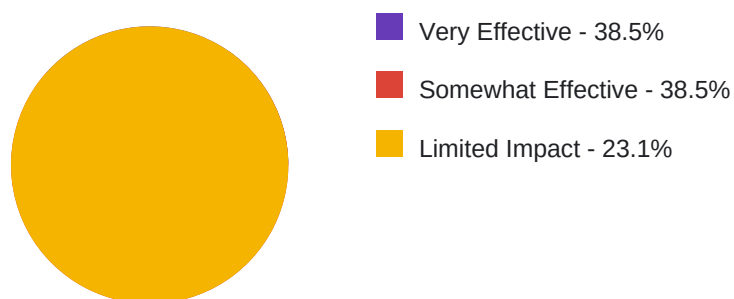
What factors limit your participation in competitions?

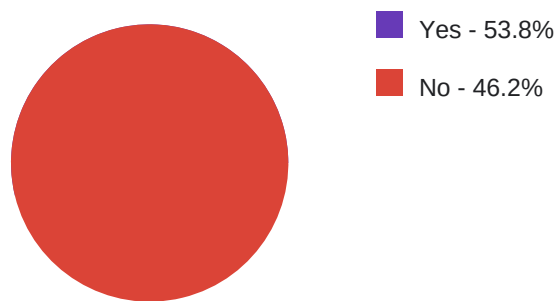
**What changes would improve your competition experience?**

- Improved process.

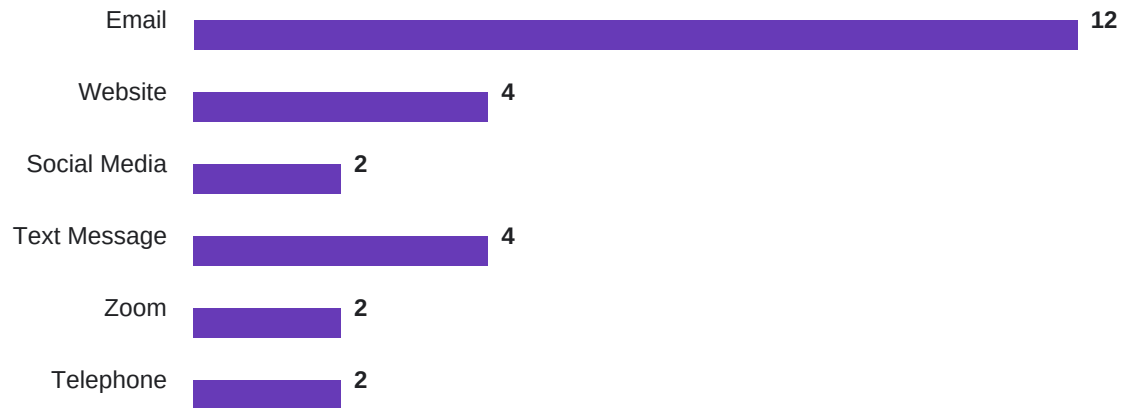
Would you attend training to improve competition scores and image presentation?

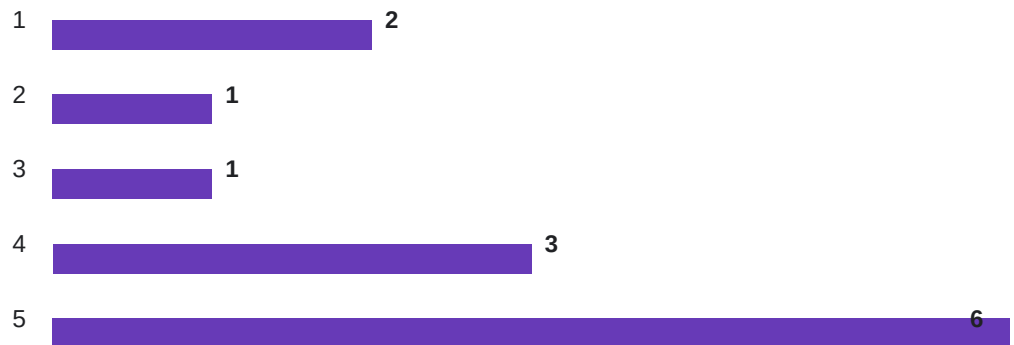
- Keep the website current with programs and events and use it to inform visitors and encourage members.

**How useful are Board reports and competition reports? (Scale 1-5)**

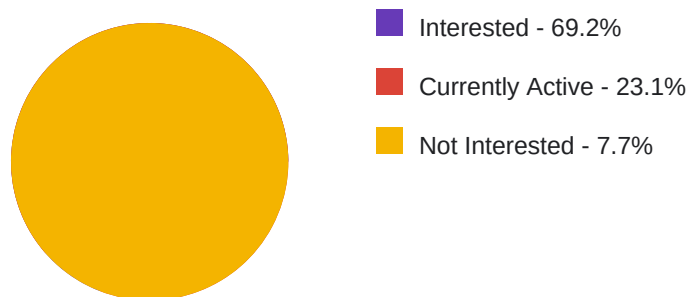

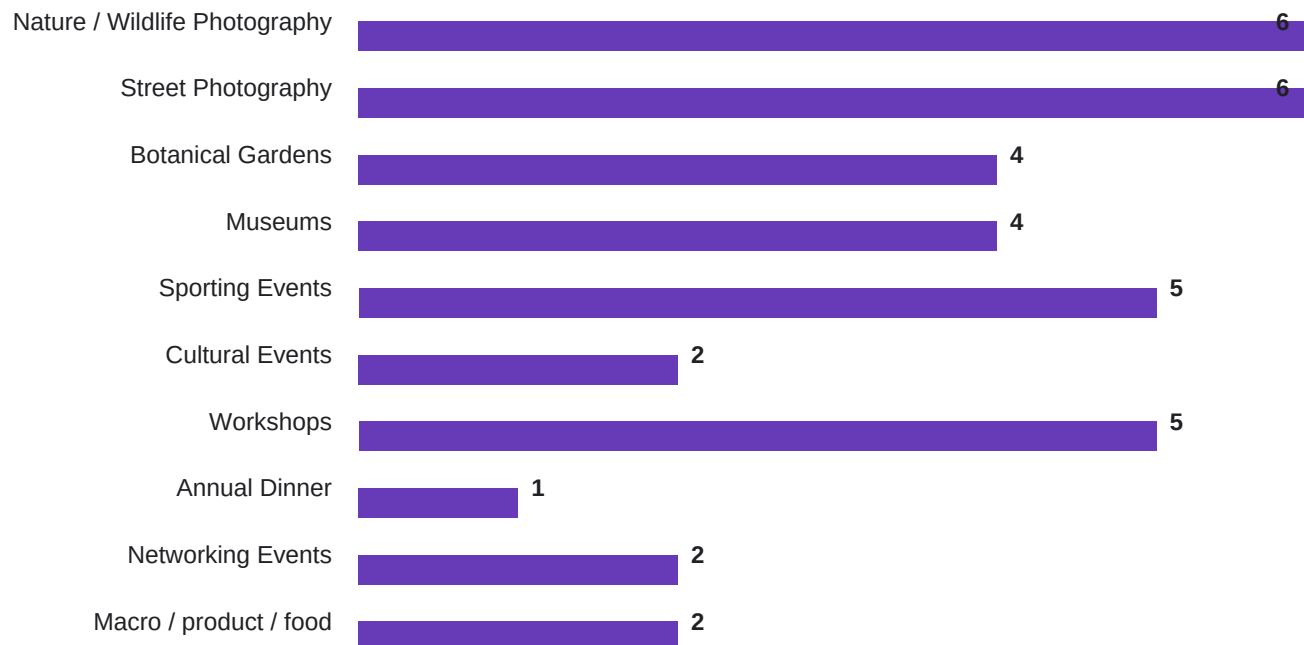

- More advertising.

- Coordinate communications among committee chairs to reduce email volume.
- Earlier meeting time.
- Communication, collaboration and planning.

Additional comments or suggestions

4 responses

- One response questioned whether the survey fully reflected membership concerns and emphasized the value of member relationships, mentoring and advice from past presidents.
- One response suggested asking 3-4 members to evaluate the results and share recommendations for moving forward.
- One response offered no additional comment.
- One response expressed hope that the survey would provide useful guidance to the Board and members.
